## **MBA UPDATE**

A weak labor market and a glut of recent graduates are upending the notion that professional degrees like an MBA are a sure ticket to financial success. For graduates with minimal experience – three years or less – median pay was down 4.6% last year to \$53,900 nationally from 2007-08. According to a Wall Street Journal study, pay fell at 62% of the schools examined. This was the case not only at less prestigious schools, but also at top programs. Debt was also an issue, with average MBA debt at \$81,758 compared with 2010.

Note: Keeping these metrics in mind, our ECU business students did relatively well in 2012 with reasonable tuition costs and a salary bump of 12% from the previous year to \$53,175 with 51% of those seeking new employment. Taking into account the relatively low cost of living in North Carolina, the starting salaries were quite competitive.
