- Hold weekly office hours and meet with students.
- Encourage active involvement in university and College of Business activities and organizations, serve as positive role models for Mentees, and share experiences and knowledge they have gained as students at ECU

Requirements:

- Minimum overall GPA of 3.0
- Completion of 60 credit hours (by August of 2013)
- 2 semesters completed at ECU
- 2 semesters remaining at ECU
- Declaration of Concentration in the College of Business
- Involvement in campus/ community service
- In good standing with the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities
- Full time status (at least 12 hours)
- Attend a 3-day, 2-night Peer Mentor training retreat the week before classes begin in August and assist with welcome programs

Stipend:

- \$500 per semester (not including summer school)
